Tower of Hope

Designed to provide comfort and peace, this tower houses 12 family lodging rooms that are carefully crafted to create a calming, restorative environment for families during their respite.

Each room is designed with thoughtful intention to provide moments of connection for our families, with private balconies with a view, a kitchenette, dining table and bathroom equipped to tailor to their needs. Creating an adaptable sleeping environment is critical to providing restful sleep for all family members. The rooms includes two queen beds and a reclining chair to provide the patient with various opportunities to be comfortable as well as remain supported by their caregiver and children. Warm colors, soft lighting, and comfortable furnishings create an atmosphere that feels like a home away from home, providing a sense of security during a time of uncertainty. Large windows in each room allow natural light to pour in, offering stunning views of the surrounding landscape, reminding guests of the beauty and hope that exists beyond their challenges.

The Tower of Hope is not just a place to rest, but also a space that nurtures emotional well-being. Each floor offers communal spaces for families to connect, share experiences, and support one another, reinforcing the sense of community, and breaking the cycle of isolation. Quiet reflection areas, accessible lounges, and calming environments are designed for families to relax and recharge, while on-site programming is available to address both physical and emotional needs.

The Therapeutic Annex is a core feature of the Tower of Healing, offering an array of evidence-based programming options designed to promote physical and emotional healing.

The art room provides a creative outlet, allowing individuals and families to express their emotions through painting, sculpture, or other artistic mediums. This form of self-expression offers a powerful way to process grief, fear, and hope in a safe, non-judgmental space.

The Movement and Mindfulness room is designed for gentle chair yoga and meditation, offering families a chance to relax, stretch, and restore balance. These calming practices help reduce stress, ease physical discomfort, and promote emotional well-being.

The Recreational Pool and hot tub provide a space for physical healing and relaxation. The pool's warm waters offer soothing relief, while the hot tub helps to ease muscle tension and promote deep relaxation. These therapeutic amenities are complemented by quiet seating areas where families can bond and rejuvenate together.

The Chapel serves as a non-denominational spiritual refuge for families seeking peace, reflection, and connection during their journey. This tranquil space welcomes all faiths, offering a quiet place for prayer, meditation, and moments of introspection.
