## THE PATRIARCH FAMILY FOUNDATION FAMILY AND VOLUNTEER LODGING



### *Your Impact*

Our Respite Center will contain twenty single family units, providing weekly lodging to sixteen families and four volunteer families/groups weekly. Our lodging has been thoughtfully planned to provide moments of connection for our families, with private balconies with a view, a kitchenette, dining table and a bathroom equipped to tailor to their needs.

Our family lodging will range in accommodating a family of four members up to eight members and four family units will be ADA accessible. Creating an adaptable sleeping environment is critical to providing restful sleep for all family members. Each unit includes two double beds and a reclining chair to provide the patient with various opportunities to be comfortable as well as remain supported by their caregiver and children. Designed with significant input from oncology professionals, the rooms will provide an oasis for our families to fully realize the therapeutic benefits of respite.



# FPS Respite Volunteer Program

Our Respite Volunteer Program is a cornerstone of the FPS Cancer Respite Center, significantly reducing labor costs and fostering engagement among past Respite Recipients and FPS stakeholders. This program not only enhances our onsite respite services but also offers a meaningful way for our community to contribute.

In addition to welcoming families and nominators, we extend our Respite Volunteer Program to oncology professionals, providing them with much-needed respite in a field often characterized by burnout and emotional exhaustion. This unique opportunity allows them to recharge and find solace in a supportive environment, remembering the true impact they have on patients each day.

Volunteering at the Cancer Respite Center offers FPS families and nominators a deeper connection to our mission. As volunteers, they play vital roles in the center's operations, support family activities, and witness our mission in action.

Everyone who participates in the Respite Volunteer Program will find the experience transformative. The bonds formed, the support given and received, and the shared moments of respite create lasting impacts on all involved.
